



This strange

And of eourse... Like a few months after I put 2 year's worth of savings to work...


New Zealand started reopening their borders.

So like, I'm debt-free for the first time in my adult life.


And the money I put into the stocks has gained 33% value.

Since 2019, it's been exploding!





And that's **PRIVATE** money: that's guys whose job it is to see what's gonna come good on the balance sheet.
